Back in 1963, our Charter members committed themselves to the idea of fraternalism by creating this Association. They committed to volunteerism when Past Presidents George Kodish, Dick Dorsty and our honoree, **Frank Bolz Jr.** took the Police / Fire Line of Duty Widows under their wings and continue to support them to the present day. In attendance each year is a man who comes to say thank you once again to Frank for saving his life at a hostage situation that Frank had defused positively.

Tony Senft** who sustained grave injuries and barely escaped with his life after a bomb detonated by the FALN on New Year's Eve in 1982 left him with multiple disabilities including the loss of one eye. Tony spent the time after his rehabilitation guiding other officers who sustained injuries on the job how to get through it.

These men have led lives that provide an example to all.

Our Board members exhibit this sense of selflessness in the work they do for the Association.
