2012 Scholarships Application Process

To qualify for Scholarships, members must be able to show proof that they have been a member of the Steuben Association for the last three years. The paying of dues for the three consecutive years at one time, just so the child may take the exam, is not permitted.

You need to fill out **three (3) applications for your College bound student and only one (1) for a High School bound Student. All STEUBEN APPLICATIONS DUE BY FEB. 17th 2012.**

1. The **NYPD Steuben Association Application** - applies for both High School and College students. Send directly to NYPD Steuben Association. Application available at NYPDSteuben.org or use above form.
2. **Police Reserve Application** - *for college only* (We will send it to you when we receive your Steuben application). Then submit your original to the Police Reserve and send a copy back to NYPD Steuben Association for our records.
3. **NYLEF Application**, - *for college only* (we will send it to you when we receive your Steuben application). Then submit your original to NYLEF and send a copy to NYPD Steuben Association.
