As we enter forty-seventh year, the organization is privileged to install **Jason Schleyer** as the new President with his Board of Officers and thank departing President **Debbie White** for her four years of service. We will have the opportunity to bestow honor to two well-deserving men: **Frank Bolz**, the originator of the Hostage Negotiation Team in the NYPD and Tony **Senft**, the co-originator of the Police Self Support Group.

We will be awarding the Ted Bielefeld Achievement Award to **Frank Bolz**, a founding member and the second man to hold the esteemed office of President of this Association, a role he held for almost eight (8) years. Frank assisted in the formulation of the Department's guidelines for dealing with barricaded felons and hostage confrontations. As Commanding Officer and Chief Negotiator of the newly developed Hostage Negotiating Team, he brought about the safe release of 850 hostages. He has authored a number of books on the subject including contributions to two counterterrorism books. Frank has been the Master of Ceremonies for the Police / Fire Line of Duty Widows Luncheon since 1966 and continues to assist and support the ladies and their scholarship fund.

Our German – American of the Year Award will be awarded to a man who has led by example. **Tony Senft** retired from the NYPD as a 1st Grade Detective this past December. He was gravely injured in a bombing outside 26 Federal Plaza on December 31, 1982 and went on to form the Police Self Support Group. This group counsels, visits and provides funding to assist officers who are severely injured or ill. Although he recently passed the Presidential gavel to his Vice President, Tony continues to be actively involved in the program of assisting other officers.
